From Woody: Frederick Buechner had a great ability as a writer to apply the words of faith to the experiences of life. Too often we preachers talk theology rather than how the theology relates to our lives. Where is God if not in the experiences of life? I think that Jesus is the prime example of God speaking to us in a way we can begin to grasp. Somehow in this carpenter from Nazareth, we can find clues to the mysteries of life itself. There are miracles around us if we but take time to look amidst the noise, the

tumult, the fears, the joys and the sadnesses of life that speak to the core of the human experience. I share a wonderful passage from the late Rev. Buechner as food for thought on a summer day:

After lecturing learnedly on miracles, a great theologian was asked to give a specific example on one. "There is only one miracle," he answered. "It is life."

- Have you wept at anything during the past year?
- Has your heart beat faster at the sight of young beauty?
- Have you thought seriously about the fact that someday you are going to die?
- More often than not do you really listen when people are speaking to you instead of just waiting for your turn to speak?
- Is there anybody you know, in whose place, if one of you had to suffer great pain, you would volunteer yourself?

If your answer to all or most of these questions is No, the chances are that you're dead.
