From Woody: The situation in the Middle East is painful to watch and just imagine what a nightmare it is for the innocent civilians caught in the midst of it. It appears that it is a religious war between Judaism and Islam. Nothing could be further from the truth. Whether God is called Yahweh or Allah, God wants peace as is taught in all the major World Religions. The October 7th attack on Israel by Hamas was horrendous. killing over 1200 Israelis that day. Israel has now killed at least 25 times that number of

Palestinians.

Eighty Jewish citizens of New Hampshire placed a full page add in the weekend UNION LEADER. The signers condemn both the Hamas attack and the response of Israel. Both sides have killed thousands of innocent human beings, just trying to live their lives. The college campuses in our country are filling with protesters, upset over the suffering of human beings in this awful situation, which could escalate at any time to involve neighboring nations. Here is a part of the ad, signed by 80 Jewish citizens of New Hampshire:

We strongly condemn Hamas's despicable and barbaric attacks on October 7. Yet that horror does not excuse killing at least 25 times as many Palestinians, whether it be in the name of revenge or security. Israel's actions serve no long-term strategic purpose. For every actual Hamas terrorist killed, Israel is creating many more potential terrorists in their place. We understand Israel's right of self-defense, and we vigorously oppose anti-Semitism, but Israel's morally indefensible overreaction has only fueled Jew-hatred that is putting both Israel and all Jews at greater risk. Opposing what is taking place in Gaza is not anti-Semitism but rather opposing the killing of innocent children and adults.

The signers call for an immediate ceasefire to allow aid workers to safely enter, and for the release of all hostages. They also call for suspension of military aid to Israel, saying, "Our tax dollars and our weapons should not go to massacre any more people, especially children. By its reckless and brutal actions, Israel has forfeited the right to receive additional, unrestricted American military aid......This is a courageous effort by our New Hampshire Jewish brothers and sisters to speak the truth and to stop the horror. To oppose the current Israeli policy is not Anti-Semitism but rather speaking out against a cruel government policy being carried out by a nation we call our friends. Let us all continue to pray for peace.
