It includes a segment from a PBS News Hour this past weekend. It is an interview with a Palestinian poet, Mosab Abu Toha. He left Gaza in December with his wife and three children. He was detained, stripped, beaten and interrogated for hours. Hours before the interview he got word that over a dozen of his

family members were killed in an Israeli airstrike. He learned later this weekend that another 22 family members were missing and believed killed in another air strike. His interview is available on YouTubePalestinian Poet Mosab Abu Toha processes the war in Gaza through his art. I share with you a poem from his new book, FOREST OF NOISE:

Every child in Gaza is me. Every mother and father is me. Every house is my heart. Every tree is my leg. Every plant is my arm. Every flower is my eye. Every hole in the earth is my wounds.

I wish I could have sent some humor. My apologies but may our prayers be that, however the Election tomorrow turns out, our country will do everything possible to end this awful war.


