From Woody: The Session just approved donating from the Helping Hand fund \$500 to ASPIR, an organization that is in New Boston and run by Noel Sagna, husband of Kary Jencks. They met when Kary was serving in the Peace Corp. ASPIR'S vision is "*To provide resources and support to refugees, resettled refugees, internally displaced persons, and returnees to improve their lives and attain their dreams and advocate for ending homelessness."*

Within the US, ASPIR provides a range of assistance aimed at helping new African refugees resettled in NH, to adjust and acquire the skills to become self-sufficient. The money we gave goes to help lawyer fees to get a 68 year old refugee a green card and work permit. Here is a description of this gentleman that Noel is working to help.

His name is Michel Lumumba. He is 68 years old and came here in 2022. He applied for asylum but was sick on the day he was supposed to be at his interview with the Immigration Office. He speaks limited English. He usually couch-surfs in Manchester where he works day jobs as he can find them. ASPIR got the lawyer to reduce his feel from \$3500 to \$2000. A last piece of information is that he is the son of Patrice Lumumba, former leader of the Congo who was murdered in 1961 when Michel was 6. He was murdered by our CIA along with factions fighting in the Congo. I am glad our church could be of some help toward the needed goal of \$2000.
